<p>Position Description</p>	<p>The field data collection project is an essential component of the III agro-ecology research program. The main goal of this SW Florida based program is to explore issues of water quality, but other types of data sets may also be involved. If the trainee is experienced with programming then he/she will be able to develop online database applications that automatically report, analyze, and graph statistical summaries of the data sets. Visualization of telemetry data from field projects is an extremely important aspect of many modern environmental studies. Intelligent data analysis systems can also be designed to automatically notify project managers of problems or conditions in the field.</p> <p>The student trainee will prepare reports summarizing the data sets and project findings. Other scientists will use the results in drawing conclusions about the field experiments.
